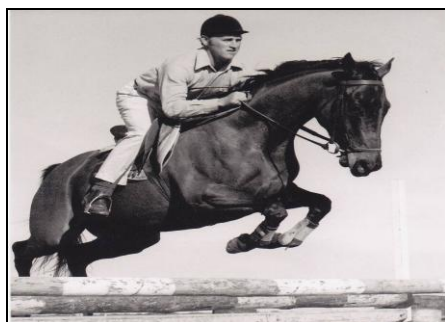

### TO BE ACCEPTED ALL ENTRIES MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY:

- [A] The appropriate ENTRY FEE
- [B] Angaston A. H. & F. Society Membership Fee - see Entry Form
- [C] All horses must be named - **PLEASE PRINT CLEARLY**
- [D] Late entries maybe accepted. A fee will apply.

Entries for events in Ring 1 i.e. Show Jumping, must indicate the grade of each horse entered. This is to facilitate the draw for each event. The draw printed on the official programme will be the official draw for the respective events.

### THE FOLLOWING GROUND RULES APPLY:-

- [1] Competitors must not tether horses to fences or trees
- [2] Do not allow your horses to damage any trees
- [3] No stationary engines near the Arena.
- [4] No electric fencing allowed according to EA Rules
- [5] No lungeing on the oval
- [6] All manure & straw to be put in appropriate receptibles

All Entry Fees include compulsory public liability insurance.

**JUNIOR RIDERS** may compete in senior & junior classes on the same horse on the same day, provided it is clearly stated on entry schedule & programme.

**RIBBONS** will be: 1<sup>st</sup> Blue, 2<sup>nd</sup> Red, 3<sup>rd</sup> White, 4<sup>th</sup> Gold, 5<sup>th</sup> Green, 6<sup>th</sup> Brown  
**\*\*\* PRIZE-MONEY will be paid in the ring following each event \*\*\***

Third prize money will be paid if there are six or more entries in any event & fourth prize will be paid if there are ten or more entries. **NOTE:-** Third Prize, ribbon only - unless stated. A ribbon only does not constitute a prize. All events in the Show Jumping Classes will be conducted under E.SA & F.E.I. Rules. **STALLIONS** - are eligible to compete in jumping class only.

**CENTRAL DISTRICT SHOWS ASSOCIATION  
RULES & REGULATIONS**

1. There will not be any transferring of entries between any classes after submission of entry except as in 2 below.
2. In the case of a horse being measured prior to the show, and a transfer being required, the current height certificate must be in the hands of the secretary/convenor by 5.00pm on the evening before the show.
3. Entry forms are to include a signed declaration by the entrant to the effect that "I have read and will abide by the rules and regulations of the show society".
4. Any coaching during judging is strictly prohibited.
5. The protest fee for horse sections in CDSA shows will be \$100.
6. Payment must accompany entry forms to validate entry – Show secretaries will not take responsibility for cash sent through the post.
7. Refunds of entry fees only on receipt of a veterinary certificate in the name of the horse, or a medical certificate for the rider.
8. CDSA shows have an expectation of entrants to conduct themselves in a spirit of good sportsmanship and fair play at all times.
9. In the event of any inconsistencies between these rules and EA or any other association or club, these rules shall prevail.
