Welcome to our 115th Angaston Show to be held over the weekend of February 24 to 26 with an action packed programme full of entertainment for all ages.

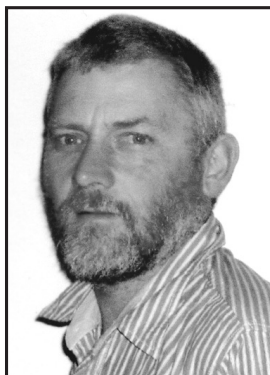
